Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether his/her dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered Keeshonden with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration are eligible to participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Signed FARPOINTS FARM RELEASE form must be included with your agility entries.

Agility entries will be included in the KCA National Catalog. These may be preordered on the Website or from the order form in the National Premium.

ONLINE ENTRIES: This trial does accept online entries through AKC Online Entry (www.akc.org). During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 100; Paper entries 230. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

WAITLIST

KCA IS OFFERING A WAIT LIST to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's official close. Only paper entries can be waitlisted. Online entries are not eligible for waitlist. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by 06:00 p.m. (PDT) on the trial's closing date. A maximum of fifty (50) runs will be placed on the club's wait list. Any entry that is withdrawn by 6 p.m. (PDT) on Monday April 22, 2019 will be replaced by a waitlisted entry IF any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday April 22, 2019 at 6 p.m. (PDT) will receive a full refund.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Course maps will be posted, and exhibitor copies available first-come, first-served. Judge's briefing and course walk-throughs will occur prior to each class. Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only (or replacement handlers if entered handler is injured).

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

REFUNDS

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if written (or email) request is received by the trial secretary on or before closing.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund all entry fees for bitches unable to compete for this reason. Notification must be received by the Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Sick or injured dogs, sick or injured handlers will receive a refund of entry fees less \$5.00 per run/day if written (e-mail) notification is received by the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Keeshond Club of America, the Trial Secretary and Farpoints Farm and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Keeshond Club of America reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Keeshond Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or confined to a crate or exercise pen when **on trial grounds** except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Additionally, an insulated lunch bag featuring a variation on this year's National Logo "Blazing New Trails" will be awarded to first through fourth place winners. Keychains will be awarded for QQ in Master Standard and Master JWW.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH, PACH, and PAX rosette and decorated MACH, PACH, PAX bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. If you are close to earning an award, please let the [Trial Chair or Trial Secretary](#) know so that the club is prepared to celebrate with you.

Award for High in Trial at Agility Trial

KCA Agility HIT will be awarded to the Keeshond with the highest point total that qualifies (minimum score of 100, with no faults) in the regular titling classes of Excellent or Master Standard and Excellent or Master Jumpers With Weaves (JWW) classes (i.e. not Preferred). Points will be awarded for each full second under Standard Course Time (SCT) for each qualifying run. If the dog qualifies in both Standard and JWW, an additional 10 points will be awarded to that dog for the HIT determination. In the event of a tie in points, then the dog with the fastest actual time for the qualifying runs will determine the winner of the HIT. If there is still a tie in both points and time, then a run-off will be held on the course of record or a course of lower skill level, whichever course is still standing at the time of the determination of the tie. The winner of the run-off based on score then time shall be awarded the HIT award.

Agility High in Trial Vulcanix Trophy - 20"x16" Metal Artwork by Vulcanix featuring a variation on this year's National Logo "Blazing New Trails". KCA also offers a silver colored medallion for High In Trial.

Most Versatile Keeshond — This year KCA will recognize the Most Versatile Keeshond. The dog (or bitch) scoring the most points in Conformation, Obedience, Rally, and Agility will be awarded a trophy and Rosette offered by Melinda Galt. Please check the "Most Versatile Keeshond Competition" box on the entry form to be included. Registrations will also be accepted at the show, but it will be easier for the organizers if most register early. No additional entry fee is required. OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on matting with 80 x 120 ft.ring.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email so that Heather (Trial Secretary) receives them by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, April 29, 2019**. Include dog's call name, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to (replying to your final CONFIRMATION EMAIL is an ideal way to complete a move-up). If you do not receive an acknowledgement of your move-up request within 24 hours of sending, please contact Heather to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.
